Day 01 ARRIVAL PERTH (SUN)

On arrival, take your airport shuttle transfer to Perth Hotel for check in rest and relax.
Overnight at hotel

Day 02 PERTH/FULL DAY 4WD PINNACLES, KOALAS & SANDBOARDING 4WD ADVENTURE (B/L)(MON)

After breakfast, We leave the city limits and cross over the Swan River travelling past Burswood Resort Casino. Then head north through the Swan Valley to Caversham Wildlife Park where we stop to view and photograph koalas and hand feed kangaroos. We move onto the Rock Lobster town of Cervantes and visit Indian Ocean Rock Lobster factory for an informative tour of the factory.

After a picnic lunch, we then continue on to the Nambung National Park, home of the amazing Pinnacles Desert. Here your driver guide takes you for an easy paced walk through parts of this fascinating landscape covering some 404 hectares. We then break at the small fishing settlement of Lancelin before the thrilling experience of 4-wheel driving in our giant 4WD over massive Lancelin sand dunes and the chance to try sand boarding. Ensure you wear comfortable footwear, bring a hat and your camera. Later enjoy a sunset journey back to Perth. If flowering, stops to view wildflowers will be made en route with arrival back in Perth at approximately 7.30 pm

Note: Tour may operate with morning in coach and afternoon in 4WD, or vice versa depending on passenger numbers. Adventure component of tour will always operate in a 4WD vehicle. Sometimes due to soft sand dunes delays may occur.

Tour not suitable for pregnant women, people with back problems and infants, if unsure please ask at the time of booking.

Day 03 PERTH-MARGARET RIVER (B/L) (TUE)

After breakfast, a leisurely drive south from Perth, through the rolling farm lands of the south west hinterland, will put you on the edge of the world-famous vineyards of Margaret River.

A stop at The Dolphin Discovery Centre is Australia's Premier Dolphin Experience. Located on the shores of Koombana Bay, visitors can experience four levels of interaction unequalled anywhere else in Australia. This includes an Interpretive Centre and Theatre, Interaction Zone, Swim Tours and Eco Cruises. As a non-profit community based organisation they are committed to dolphin research, education, conservation and tourism. Lunch will be served at a local restaurant while enjoying the views overlooking the Bunbury Harbour

After lunch continue journey and visit to Busselton Jetty- The longest wooden jetty in the southern hemisphere. The Busselton Jetty is one of Western Australia's most popular eco-tourism attractions, boasting a unique underwater observatory located nearly two kilometres out to sea. We then continue to Natural Olive Oil Soap Factory. The Factory was built using recycled timbers from the Busselton Jetty as well as Wandoo or White Gum from Kojonup Western Australia and corrugated tin in-keeping with the country, down to earth spirit of the products within.

The factory itself was a machinery shed that has been renovated in order to allow visitors to the factory to overlook the soap making process from a mezzanine level and to be able to interact with the soap maker and the staff, providing the opportunity to see how some of their unique products are made.

Thereafter you can experience Sunset Kangaroo Safari (seasonal) or Sunset Scenic Tour before check in hotel at Margaret Beach Resort or Similar.

Day 04 MARGARET RIVER (B/L) (WED)

After breakfast, Share in the local knowledge with our experienced tour guides allowing you to explore more of Margaret River. Your day will be filled by award winning, iconic and boutique wines and beer, fresh local produce and stunning art and scenery. A personalised wine tastings at four exceptional wineries and visit two galleries including one of Australia's most famous cartoonist – Paul Rigby's work is celebrated internationally. Lunch will be served at local brewery including a complimentary glass of beer or wine.

After lunch, sample local produce at the Venison Farm, Olio Bello and the Margaret River Cheese and Chocolate Factories.

Return to hotel rest and relax

Day 05 MARGARET RIVER/PERTH (B/L) (THU)

After breakfast, We visit Redgate beach with its stories of the Shipwrecks. We then continue with a scenic drive through the majestic Boranup Forest visiting Boranup Gallery to see the beautiful and creative wood designs and furniture.

Our next stop Jewel Cave is Western Australia's largest show cave and is home to one of the longest straw stalactites found in any tourist cave in the world.

The caverns of Jewel Cave sink to a depth of 42 metres and stretch 1.9 kilometres long. Your guide will take you on an incredible and informative journey following 700 meters of walk ways and stairs through several large caverns.

Inside the cave you will be bewildered by the colossal formations. The first descent takes you down a long, narrow tunnel which opens into a giant cavern. Jewel Cave creates the sensation of being under the ocean without the water. It has a soft golden glow and the sheer magnitude of its structure dwarfs its visitors.

Jewel Cave is home to many impressive formations. Soon after entering the cave you will see its most famous formation, the straw stalactite that hangs delicately 5.4 metres from the ceiling. Your imagination will come alive in this cave – try to spot the organ pipes, giant shawl, friendly ghost, Jedi and the jewellery box.

Locals knew about the cave for many decades but it wasn't properly explored until 1958 when two intrepid explorers, Lex Bastian and Lloyd Robinson, were brave enough to discover its depths. The following year, Jewel Cave was opened to the public and became an iconic tourism attraction.

Jewel Cave has revealed many surprises over the years, including the remains of a Thylacine, which is now safely stored by the Western Australian Museum.

Thereafter, pass through Augusta with views of Blackwood River to arrive at Cape Leeuwin Lighthouse where two oceans meet, the Southern ocean meets with Indian ocean. Take a guided tour of Australia's tallest mainland lighthouse then enjoy a tasty lunch at the café.

Free time in Margaret River for any last minute purchases before return to Perth.

Arrive Perth, check in hotel rest and relax

After breakfast, check out and free until transfer by Airport Shuttle bus for your departure flight.
