D1 Kuala Lumpur / Osaka

Assemble at the KLIA International Airport for your flight to Osaka Kansai airport.

D2 Arrival Osaka / Nagoya (D)

Osaka Castle – was built in the end of the century by Toyotomi Hideyoshi, a well-known warlord who brought the whole country under his rule in the late 16th century.

Shinsaibashi - Largest shopping area in Osaka where you can have unique and vibrant shopping experience

Oasis 21 – is a modern facility located adjacent to Nagoya TV Tower in Sakae Nagoya. It contains restaurants, stores and a bus terminal, as well as the tourist information.

Hotel: Castle Plaza Hotel or similar

D3 Nagoya / Shirakawa Village / Kanazawa (B/L/D)

Gujo Museum – Demonstrations of Gujo's festival dances are held several times a day. The rest of the museum is noteworthy as well, with English explanations on all of the displays about the town's water system, history and crafts.

Food Replica – Food replicas are the wax or plastic representations of dishes that many restaurants in Japan put on display to entice and inform patrons Gujo Hachiman has been a center of food replica production for decades, and maintains four replica workshops.

Shirakawago Village – a well-preserved UNESCO World heritage Site to view its old farmhouses with steep roofs resembling two hands folded for a prayer.

Kenrokuen Garden – in Kanazawa city, one of the three great gardens of Japan.

Hotel: Kanazawa Excel Hotel or similar

D4 Kanazawa / Nagano (B/L/D)

Tateyama Kurobe Alpine Route – that links Toyama and Nagano prefectures. During the journey, view **Tateyama**, which along with Mt Fuji and Mt Hakusan is one of Japan's 3 Sacred Mountains and has been worshiped since ancient times. Admire the Magnificent **Tateyama Range**, a spectacular and solemn display of peaks which forms a picturesque alpine scene. This majestic range can be traversed via 6 different transportations : Tateyama cable car, Tateyama highland bus, Tateyama tunnel trolley bus,

Tateyama ropeway, Kurobe cable car and Kanden tunnel trolley bus, Along the way, pass by the 350 metre high **Shomyo-Daki**, the highest waterfall in Japan. Explore the famous **Kurobe Alps**, also known as the spinal core of Japan, for its unique diversity of floras and alps sceneries. Next, be enthralled by **Kurobe Dam**, one of the greatest man made wonders in the world.

Note : The visit to the snow corridor is subject to weather conditions and the opening period by the local authorities.

Hotel: Yatsugatake Royal Hotel or similar Hotel

D5 Nagano / Lake Kawaguchi (B/L/D)

Mt Fuji – drive up to 5th station of Mt.Fuji to enjoy a panoramic view of the surrounding lake district (if weather not permitting, visit to Fuji Visitor Centre).

Soba Making – get to hands-on to make your very own soba for an authentic experience like no others

Fruit Picking – Enjoy the fruits picking. (subject to weather condition)

Fruits season [for reference only]: (May-Jun) Cherry; (Mid Jun-Mid Aug) Blueberry; (Jul-Aug) Peach; (Sep-Nov) Pear, Apple.

Hotel: Tokyo Dome Hotel or similar

D6 Lake Kawaguchi / Tokyo (B/L/D)

Asakusa Kannon Temple - Most famous and popular Buddhist temple built in the 7th Century.

Nakamise Street - more than 50 shops, which offer local specialties and tourist souvenirs

Odaiba – is a popular shopping and entertainment district on a man made island in Tokyo Bay.

Palette Town – is a large shopping and entertainment complex consisting of the Venus Fort shopping mall, **Toyota Mega Web**, a Ferris Wheel, the Zepp Tokyo music venue and Tokyo Leisureland.

Ginza - the most prestigious and fashionable shopping & dining town in Tokyo. Shopping at Uniqlo & H&M shop.
